Understanding the neglected firm effect

First Point

• Smaller firms aren't subject to the same scrutiny and analysis as larger companies

Second Point

- Analysts have more information about blue-chips or large and well-known companies in general and therefore more opinion and recommendations
- Due to the high interest on well-known companies it's often times more lucrative to have much data about them

Third Point

• Information on smaller firms is often limited to the fillings that are required by law -> therefore the firms are "neglected"


Why do they outperform blue-chips?

- Investors discover the stocks
 - Not enough interest for analysts
 - Investors usually use the RSI or the P/E Ratio to identify wether neglected stocks are worth buying or not
- The size of the stock plays a big role on how much the neglected stocks will outperform
- It is said that larger neglected stocks do not perform any better than expected while smaller stocks do

Key takeaways
